- MTEF's vision for 2009 is that the Community Building Initiative and the Community Partnership Investment will lead to significantly healthier people in the neighborhood by creating an advisory board of doctors and dieticians that will work with the local council of community leaders and parents to promote healthy lifestyles through the game of tennis.



Community Learning Center Wellness Program Fees, Programs, & Vendor Prices

On-Site Staff Hourly Fees

Head Coach = \$50/hr.

Assistant Coaches = \$21/hr.

High School Volunteers = FREE

Four Programmatic Options

- 1) 5-6 yr. old QuickStart Tennis on 36' Court
(30 or 45 minute session recommended)
- 2) 7-8 yr. old QuickStart Tennis on 36' Court
(1 hr. session recommended)
- 3) 9-10 yr. old QuickStart Tennis on 60' Court
(1 hour session recommended)
- 4) 11-14 yr. old Regular Tennis on 78' (full) Court
(60 or 90 minute session recommended)

School Year Site

Sample: 4 wk, 1hr/day, 2 days/wk, 24 children (6:1 coach-to-player ratio)

1 Head Coach @ \$50 x 1 hr/day x 2 days/wk. x 4 weeks = \$400

2 Asst. Coaches @ \$21 x 1 hr/day x 2 days/wk. x 4 weeks = \$336

1 High School Volunteer = Free

Total

\$400 + \$336 + 0 = \$736 for a 4-wk, 24 children program

Summer Day Camp or CLC/Safe & Sound Site

Sample: 1 wk, 1 hr, 5 days, 24 children (6:1 coach-to-player ratio)

1 Head Coach @ \$50 x 1 hr/day x 5 days/wk. = \$250/week

2 Asst. Coaches @ \$21 x 1 hr/day x 5 days/wk = \$105/week

1 High School Volunteer = Free

Total

\$250 + \$105 + 0 = \$355 for a 5-day, 1-week, 24 children program

Vendor Equipment Fees

*** As an official MPS vendor, MTEF will sell tennis equipment to CLC locations for the following prices:**

- QuickStart Foam Balls = \$300 for 32 dozen
- Transition Tennis Balls = \$89 for 72 balls
- Throw Down Long Lines for Gym surfaces = \$33 for 6 lines
- Caution Tape = \$35 for 1,000 feet
- Throw Down Lines / Corner Markers = \$38 for one dozen
- Throw Down Spots = \$35 for 6
- QuickStart Tennis Nets = \$112 for One (1) 18' net
- Coaches Tennis Cart (holds 325 balls) = \$185
- Prince Practice Balls = \$92/case
- Trophies = \$9 per trophy
- Workshop Training Fee = \$30/person
