Thank you for participating in the 2009 MTEF Summer Tennis & Reading Program. I hope you have enjoyed your experience with us this summer. The Sherman Park program will be held twice a week throughout the school year on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. at the Mary Ryan Boys & Girls Club which is located at 3000 N. Sherman Blvd., Milwaukee, WI 53210. The tennis runs from 5:00 – 6:00 and the academics run from 6:00 – 7:00. In addition, students will be served dinner between 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. and will receive a *free* membership to the Mary Ryan Boys & Girls Club.

Players will be given ample opportunity to compete and improve their tennis. Parents must be committed to making sure that their child attends at least 80% of all scheduled programming. Parents must also agree to turn in copies of report cards for every child throughout the programming.
